Commencement Speaker



Vice Admiral Regina M. Benjamin

Regina M. Benjamin, MD, MBA, is the 18th Surgeon General of the United States Public Health Service. As America's Doctor, she provides the public with the best scientific information available on how to improve their health and the health of the nation. Dr. Benjamin also oversees the operational command of 6,500 uniformed health officers who serve in locations around the world to promote, protect, and advance the health of the American People.

Dr. Benjamin is Founder and Former Chief Executive Officer of the Bayou La Batre Rural Health Clinic in Alabama, former Associate Dean for Rural Health at the University of South Alabama College of Medicine in Mobile, and immediate Past Chair of the Federation of State Medical Boards of the United States. In 1995, she was the first physician under age 40 and the first African-American woman to be elected to the American Medical Association Board of Trustees. She served as President of the American Medical Association Education and Research Foundation and Chair of the AMA Council on Ethical and Judicial Affairs (CEJA). In 2002 she became President of the Medical Association State of Alabama, making her the first African-American female president of a State Medical Society in the United States.

Dr. Benjamin has a BS in chemistry from Xavier University, New Orleans; an MD degree from the University of Alabama, Birmingham; an MBA from Tulane University; and 11 honorary doctorates. She attended Morehouse School of Medicine and completed her family medicine residency in Macon, Georgia. She established a clinic in a small fishing village in Alabama to help its uninsured residents. Dr. Benjamin persevered through Hurricane Georges in 1998, Hurricane Katrina in 2005, and a devastating fire in 2006, often putting up her own money to cover expenses. She also became nationally prominent for her business acumen and humane approach to preventive medicine.

Dr. Benjamin is a member of the National Academy of Science's Institute of Medicine, and a Fellow of the American Academy of Family Physicians. She was a Kellogg National Fellow and a Rockefeller Next Generation Leader. Some of her numerous board memberships include the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation, the Kaiser Commission on Medicaid and the Uninsured, the Catholic Health Association, and the Morehouse School of Medicine.

In 1998, Dr. Benjamin was the United States recipient of the Nelson Mandela Award for Health and Human Rights. She was named by *Time Magazine* as one of the "Nation's 50 Future Leaders Age 40 and Under." She was featured in a *New York Times* article, "Angel in a White Coat," in *People Magazine*, on the December 1999 cover of *Clarity Magazine* and was on the January 2003 cover of *Reader's Digest*. She was also named "Person of the Week" on *ABC's World News Tonight with Peter Jennings*, and "Woman of the Year" by *CBS This Morning*. She received the 2000 National Caring Award which was inspired by Mother Teresa, received the papal honor Pro Ecclesia et Pontifice from Pope Benedict XVI, and was awarded a MacArthur Genius Award Fellowship.

Honorary Degree Recipients



James T. Broyhill
Doctor of Laws, *Honoris Causa*

Two families are forever intertwined with the history of Appalachian State University: the Dougherty brothers who founded Watauga Academy which evolved into Appalachian, and the Broyhill family, starting with Satie and Ed Broyhill who were among the first students to attend the academy and later became benefactors of the university. They had two sons, both of whom we honor today.

The Honorable James T. “Jim” Broyhill of Winston-Salem has built a legacy of service to Appalachian, the state and the nation. For 24 years, he represented North Carolina as a U.S. Congressman and U.S. Senator in Washington, D.C. After service in Congress, Senator Broyhill chaired the N.C. Board of Economic Development from 1987–89. He was secretary of the N.C. Department of Commerce from 1989–91. While Commerce Secretary, North Carolina was the number one state in the nation in attracting new and expanded businesses and jobs.

He was appointed by Governor Jim Hunt as co-chairman of the N.C. Welfare to Work Business Council from 1998–2000 and also served 12 years as a member of the N.C. Chamber of Commerce’s Economic Development Committee, including six years as chairman. In 1993 and again in 2000, he was named co-chair of the campaign for the successful passage of a statewide bond referendum for capital funds for various state programs and educational institutions, which have been of great benefit to Appalachian State University.

He served for nine years on the Appalachian State University Board of Trustees, including one year as chairman, and is a former member of the Appalachian State University Foundation Board of Directors, An Appalachian Summer Festival Advisory Board, and was honorary co-chair of the Athletics Facilities Enhancement Committee.

Senator Broyhill has a long list of various local and state boards on which he has served and continues to serve. However, his support of Appalachian State University programs and activities would be the most numerous on that list and includes: the construction of Appalachian House, the chancellor’s residence; An Appalachian Summer Festival; the Athletics Facilities Campaign; and Belk Library and Information Commons. In addition, he worked closely with Chancellor Kenneth E. Peacock in the founding of the Harlan E. Boyles Distinguished CEO Lecture Series in the Walker College of Business and chaired the effort to raise funds to endow this program. He was named an honorary alumnus of the university in 2000 by the Appalachian Alumni Association.

Senator Broyhill’s papers from his years in office are housed in Appalachian’s Belk Library and Information Commons. The collection includes legislative files, newspaper clippings, speeches, video and audio tapes, photographs and other materials. Senator Broyhill is married to Louise Broyhill. They have three grown children.

Appalachian State University’s Board of Trustees has awarded Senator James T. Broyhill the Doctor of Laws, honoris causa, for his lifetime of public service and contributions to the state, higher education and to Appalachian.



Paul H. Broyhill
Doctor of Letters, *Honoris Causa*

Hard work, achievement and humanitarianism are hallmarks of the Broyhill Family. Just as his brother, The Honorable James T. Broyhill, excelled in politics, Mr. Paul H. Broyhill of Lenoir distinguished himself throughout the state as an innovative marketer, successful businessman and philanthropist.

He joined his family's business, Broyhill Furniture Industries, after graduating from college and quickly made his mark on the industry. He worked in various departments, took charge of sales and merchandising, and in the early 1960s, he became president and Chief Executive Officer, a position he held until his retirement in 1985. He promoted the company on national television game shows and in home magazines, making the Broyhill brand one of the best known furniture companies in the United States. He developed an internal Broyhill University to train, empower and motivate employees. Under his leadership, company sales grew from approximately \$10 million to \$325 million and employment rose from 1,000 to 7,500.

Education and philanthropy have long been a focus for Mr. Broyhill. He leads the charitable organization that he and his father established in 1946, the Broyhill Family Foundation. It is one of the largest private foundations in Western North Carolina and has donated tens of millions of dollars to support the arts, civic projects, hospitals, schools, and other local, regional, state, and national philanthropic organizations. Since 1982, he and the Broyhill Family Foundation have sponsored the Broyhill Leadership Conferences designed to help young people become effective leaders. More than 30,000 students in the tenth through twelfth grades have attended the five-day conferences. Mr. Broyhill also has been an avid supporter of Junior Achievement. He has established business department endowments at various schools including Appalachian.

Mr. Broyhill made the lead gift that led to the establishment of Watauga Medical Center's Wellness Center in Boone, which is named in his honor. Mr. Broyhill served on Appalachian's Board of Trustees from 1977–1985. He is a former member of An Appalachian Summer Festival Advisory Board. His support of university programs and activities includes the Appalachian House, the chancellor's residence; An Appalachian Summer Festival; the Turchin Center for the Visual Arts; the Athletics Facilities Campaign; Broyhill Inn and Conference Center; scholarship and program support in the College of Fine and Applied Arts, Hayes School of Music, Heltzer Honors Program, Reich College of Education, Walker College of Business; the Yosef Club; and Go Abroad: International Appalachian Scholarship.

Mr. Broyhill remains active in business. He manages a registered mutual fund, a hedge fund and a real estate portfolio. He is a lifetime Deacon at the First Baptist Church in Lenoir. He is the third person in his family to be inducted into the North Carolina Business and Industry Hall of Fame. He is also a member of the Furniture Manufacturers Hall of Fame. He is married to Karen Rabon Broyhill. He and his late wife, Faye, were married for 46 years prior to her death. The couple have three grown children.

Appalachian State University's Board of Trustees has awarded Mr. Paul H. Broyhill the Doctor of Letters, honoris causa, for his impact as a successful businessman, philanthropist and civic leader who has benefited the entire state.



Mary Elizabeth "Jerri" Heltzer
Doctor of Humane Letters, *Honoris Causa*

Mrs. Jerri Heltzer has a long-standing reputation for helping students in need. Mrs. Heltzer, and her late husband Harry, have mentored dozens of students who wanted to attend Appalachian State University but lacked the financial support to do so.

The Heltzers became interested in working with Appalachian after moving from Minnesota to be near Mrs. Heltzer's family in Lenoir, following Mr. Heltzer's retirement as Chief Executive Officer and Chairman of 3M in 1976. Mrs. Paul Broyhill, also a Lenoir resident, piqued their interest in helping students who lacked the resources to attend college. The couple never paid for tuition, but helped students with student fees, clothing, school supplies and other costs associated with attending college. It was important to the Heltzers that students learn that they could be self-sufficient and find a way to further their education, even with limited finances.

In 2005, the University's Honors Program was re-named the Heltzer Honors Program in the couple's honor, and this program has now become the Heltzer Honors Program for International Education within the new Honors College, which enrolls more than 800 students. The college offers opportunities to broaden and enrich students' academic experience through special classes in several fields. Emphasis is placed on independent and creative thinking, discussion, and exchange of ideas. In order to graduate with University Honors, honors students must have a 3.45 cumulative GPA, complete the 24-credit honors course curriculum, produce an original thesis or project, and have an international educational experience. The latter requirement is now possible through the Heltzer Honors Program for International Education.

Mrs. Heltzer was the seventh of 11 children. Her father was a civil engineer and her mother was a teacher and Appalachian graduate. She received her nickname, "Jerri," from a sister who had a penchant for giving family members nicknames.

Mrs. Heltzer knows the opportunities a college degree can bring. She received her high school's valedictorian scholarship to attend the Women's College of the University of North Carolina, now known as UNC-Greensboro. She graduated in 1952. After teaching for a year, Mrs. Heltzer moved to Washington, D.C., where she had a 23-year career working for government agencies, including the U.S. House of Representatives and the U.S. Senate. She ended her professional career as chief of congressional and public services for the U.S. State Department's Passport Office.

Mrs. Heltzer has been active in a variety of civic and philanthropic activities. She has served for many years on the board of directors of Caldwell Halfway House, the Wig Bank of Caldwell County and Gardner Webb University. She received the 2010 Caldwell County Distinguished Woman of the Year Award from the Council for Women of Caldwell County. Mrs. Heltzer is a member of First Baptist Church of Lenoir. Five generations of Mrs. Heltzer's family have attended Appalachian, and she currently has five nieces and nephews enrolled at the university.

Appalachian State University's Board of Trustees has awarded Mrs. Heltzer the Doctor of Humane Letters, honoris causa, for her significant contributions of service and leadership to the university, the lasting impact she has made on the institution's quality of education and the opportunities provided for students.

ACADEMIC REGALIA

The tradition of academic costumes probably originated in the traditions and necessities of the Middle Ages, when people dressed in keeping with their class and for their needs. Warm cloaks and hoods were needed because many of the buildings where scholars taught were cold. From the various traditions that grew up surrounding academic costumes, a code was established and subscribed to in 1894 by most universities and colleges in the United States. Now that academic costumes are prescribed, audiences can identify the institutions awarding degrees, the nature of the degrees and the faculties awarding them.

The bachelor of arts gown is black, closed in front with long pointed sleeves. The square Oxford cap and tassel are black. The bachelor's hood is rarely worn.

The master of arts gown is black with long closed sleeves and a short slit near the elbow to free the hand and forearm. The gown is frequently worn open but may be worn closed. Both cap and tassel are black.

The doctor's gown, usually also black, is worn open or closed, and has velvet panels five inches wide extending down the front edge to the bottom and three horizontal bars on each sleeve. Panels and bars are often black but may be a color indicating the faculty granting the degree. The doctor's costume also includes the square Oxford cap with a gold tassel worn on the left side.

Hoods show the greatest degree of symbolism. Hoods are black with velvet borders in the color of the faculty in which the degree is granted. Thus for the B.A. the border is white; for the B. S. it is golden yellow; for the B.D., purple; and so on for all faculties. The lining of the hood is silk in the colors of the institution granting the degree.

The bachelor's hood is three feet long, with a two-inch velvet border; the master's is three and one-half feet long, with a three-inch velvet border. The doctor's hood is four feet long, with a five-inch velvet border.

THE MACE

The Appalachian State University mace is carried by a senior faculty member in all academic processions. Traditionally, the mace bearer precedes the chancellor of an institution, both upon entering and leaving a ceremony. The mace serves as a symbol of authority just as it did during the Middle Ages when a mace bearer accompanied an official taking office or opening court. The Appalachian Mace symbolizes the University's mountain heritage, the rustic location and the sophistication of an emerging, national leader in higher education. Its design, as a walking stick with a base constructed of roughhewn log and finished molding, is appropriate to the natural environment of the area. At the top of the mace is a soaring, red-tailed hawk, native to the area. The hawk symbolizes power, authority as well as the empowerment of education. The talons are grasping a sphere containing two quartz crystals. The first crystal represents the global nature of the University, its educational programs, alumni, and students. The second quartz crystal within the sphere is a reproduction of Grandfather Mountain.

The letters ASU relieved within the pine cone are done in black enamel and are gold plated. The various bands represent the flora and fauna native to the area. The black walnut, one of the strongest of woods, was used to symbolize the staying power of the University.

The mace was constructed by Carolina Bronze of Asheville. Fittingly, two Appalachian students and an Appalachian graduate were involved in the production. It was commissioned by the Appalachian Alumni Association in 1994.

THE MEDALLION

As symbols of events and affiliation, medallions date back to antiquity. In academic regalia the use of medallions is traced to religious orders of the Middle Ages when a number of orders had as a badge an oval medallion. Since many orders, societies, and universities utilized in their medallion designs the circle, star, oval, or cross, detailed artwork in the center of the medallion was adopted to differentiate the medallions. Colleges and universities have traditionally used both ceremonial and commemorative medallions. As part of the ninety-fifth anniversary of Appalachian State University, a commemorative medallion was commissioned in 1994 and is worn by the chancellor on ceremonial occasions.
